

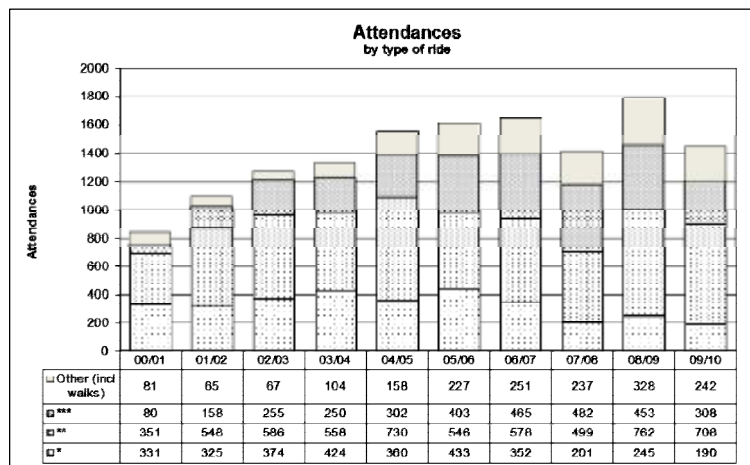
# Central London CTC

## Annual Report 2009-10

We can look back on another year where we have successfully carried on doing what we do very well. We continue to run our year round Sunday program. We also had two Easter tours and Dave Newman led tours in France in May and June. Our Saturday walks also continue to be very successful. Attendance on our off-road rides has been lower this year. Although they are not one of our core activities, while members are interested in them, we will continue to run these rides, though mostly during summer months.

During the year, CLCTC affiliated with the Road Time Trail Council (RTTC). Some of our 3\* riders have expressed interest in time trialling. Entry to time trial requires membership of an affiliated club. We will see how this goes next season.

It has become customary to produce attendance statistics at the AGM. The statistics indicate a significant drop in ride attendance. However, the amount of rides monies shown in the club accounts has fallen by a smaller proportion. Our rides income is down about £100 on last year, but is higher than the two



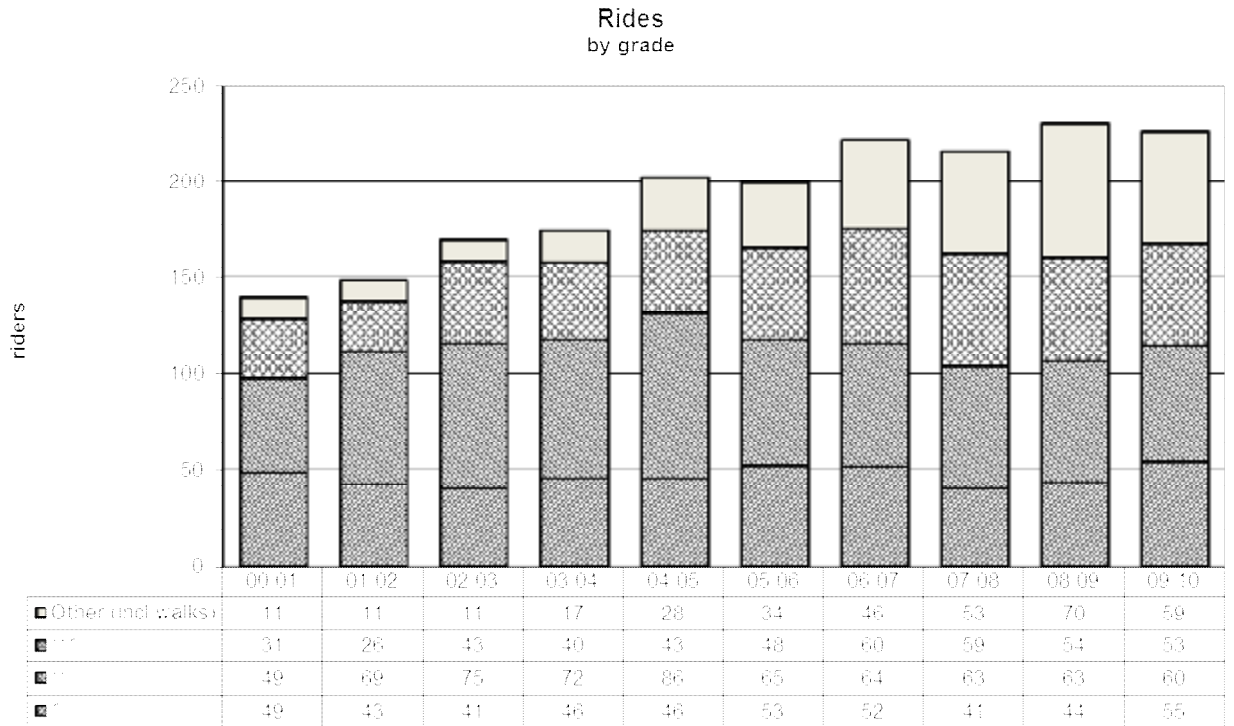
previous years. So either we are getting better at collecting the rides monies or worse at collecting attendance statistics!

There is no doubt that we were affected by the exceptionally poor weather in January and February where we had to cancel a number of rides. Allowing for that, I think that there has only been very small reduction in rides numbers. Average attendance level on rides has barely changed.

Our biggest and continuing challenge, across all types of ride, remains getting leaders to lead rides, without whom there is no club. The rides coordinators work hard on each rides list to fill their quota of rides. We need to continue to find ways to help people to lead rides. I am pleased to be able to say that during the year we had 6 new leaders, with others scheduled to lead in next year.

At the end of my first year as secretary my thanks goes to our leaders and the committee who do all the real work of running the club.
